


Monday 8th April - Pirate Day

#### How to make a booking:

1. Enrolments

Families must be enrolled in the service. Enrolment forms can be obtained from the webpage: https://www.immanuel.gld.edu.au/belong/outside-school-hours-care/

2. Xplor

You will be invited to join our booking management system Xplor. You must accept email invitation and then download the Xplor Home app to create an account.

3. Compete Booking Form

Complete and return booking forms. Email to oshc@immanuel.qld.edu.au

Bookings will only be accepted if all fees are paid up to date and there is a nil balance.

#### Fees 2023:

- \$62 per child per day (less CCS)
- \$31 per child for half day (indicate 1/2 am or pm day on booking form)
- Additional \$25 for an excursion (less CCS)
- Additional fees for excursions and activities as per program (less CCS).

Fees as of 2nd January 2024

- \$66 per child per day (less CCS)
- \$33 per child for half day (indicate 1/2 am or pm on booking form

#### Payment:

1. You will be emailed a statement fortnightly.

- 2. The statement is due for payment two weeks after the date of issue.

When using direct deposit please note your family name in the reference. 4. Late payments will incur \$10.00 fee every 14 days until payment is made. Cancellation:

- Cancellations must be made 5 working days prior to the date of the booking.
- Anytime after this, that day's fee will be incurred
- Notify OSHC via email if your child is not able to attend the booked day.

Late Booking Fees:

Bookings that are received after 8am the day before a required day, a \$10.00 fee will be applied.

Complying Written Agreement (CWA)

Child Care Subsidy (CCS):

Child Care Subsidy is paid directly to the childcare service. Families will pay 'the gap' fee. ILC OSHC will enrol families into CCS using parent CRN and child CRN. If you do not complete all requirements in MyGov, your account will be charged the full fee.

These steps must be followed to incur CCS:

- 1. Log onto your Xplor Home App
- 2. Accept the CWA in the Finance tab. Finance tab can be found in the Accounts tab (bottom right-hand corner). CWA must be accepted for each child.

IMPORTANT: Is your enrolment still valid?

The government ceases a CCS enrolment if the child has not attended the service in the past 10 weeks. Please contact OSHC if this applies to your child as we need to re-enroll your child into the CCS so you can use the CCS as a fee deduction.

Agreement:

By signing the booking form, you are agreeing to this (CWA between ILC OSHC and yourself).

Specific Child Needs:

We aim to provide an inclusive service. Please advise staff in your child requires additional support or has specific needs (i.e dietary, neurologically).

What to bring:

- Sun smart hat (No Caps)
- Apply sunscreen before attending & sign register on arrival
- · Change of clothes
- · Water bottle
- · Enclosed shoes
- No heelies, skateboards, toys or electronics.

Sign In and Collection:

Children are to be signed in and collected by an authorised nominee. Caregivers must use the Xplor Home app to sign their child in/out of the Service. ID may be required to be sighted by Educators. If you require an additional authorised nominee to collect your child, please email OSHC.
