Please note: The scholarship applies to tuition fees only and does not cover additional costs such as resource levy, camps, uniforms, etc.

Eligibility

- Available for students entering Years 6 to 11 in 2026
- Open to both current and prospective students
- Not available to full overseas fee-paying students
- Students must demonstrate high academic achievement and dedication to studies



Application Process

1. Submit Application

- Register online via our Academic Scholarship Application Portal
- Pay the \$100.00 registration fee to Edutest (our independent testing organisation)
- Registration fee is non-refundable if candidate doesn't attend the test
- 2. Required Documentation
 - When prompted by Edutest, upload:
 - Last two academic reports
 - Most recent NAPLAN results
 - Any other relevant supporting documentation

3. Testing Day

- Attend scholarship testing at Immanuel Lutheran College
- Testing is conducted by Edutest, an independent organisation
- The College does not provide candidates with actual scores or order of merit

4. Interview Stage

- Shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview with the Principal or appointed delegate
- All candidates (successful and unsuccessful) will be notified of outcomes via email



Academic Requirements

During Scholarship

Recipients must:

- Maintain Academic Excellence (Gold or Blue Award) each semester
- Study General subjects with an ATAR pathway in Years 11 & 12 (excludes Applied subjects)
- Demonstrate consistent attendance and participation
- Uphold College values and behaviour standards

Performance Review

- Academic performance and commitment reviewed each semester
- Must maintain exemplary academic standards
- Regular participation in College activities expected

Terms and Conditions

Eligibility and Award

- 1. Scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the Principal
- 2. Open to domestic students only (not available to full overseas feepaying students)
- 3. Available for students entering Years 6 to 11 in 2026

Duration and Maintenance

- Scholarships cover the entire period of enrolment at Immanuel
- Recipients must, throughout their entire scholarship period:
- Maintain exemplary academic performance
- Demonstrate consistent attendance
- Participate in College events as requested
- Uphold College values and behaviour standards



Performance Review Process

The College reserves the right to assess a student's performance or conduct at any time. If requirements are not met:

- 1. First Step: Counselling session scheduled
- 2. Second Step: Formal warning letter issued detailing required scholarship requirements
- **3.** Final Step: If a second unsatisfactory review occurs, the Principal may reduce or revoke the scholarship

Additional Conditions:

Scholarship may be rescinded if College regulations or policies are breached

Scholarships cannot be deferred for a later year of entry

If a student leaves the College (whether withdrawing or cancelling enrolment) and later returns, their scholarship will not be reinstated

Only one scholarship may be held at a time
