

Scholarship Value

- Up to 50% reduction in tuition fees
- Application and enrolment confirmation fees waived for new students
- Scholarship duration covers your entire enrolment period at Immanuel (subject to meeting conditions)

Please note: The scholarship applies to tuition fees only and does not cover additional costs such as resource levy, camps, uniforms, etc.

Eligibility

- Minimum two years' experience in community theatre productions
- Active participation in drama workshops
- Current involvement with an amateur theatre group
- Sound academic achievement
- Available for students entering Years 7 to 11 in 2026



Application Process

1. Submit Application

- Apply online via our Drama Scholarship Application Form
- Pay the \$100.00 registration fee to Edutest (our independent testing organisation)
- Registration fee is non-refundable if candidate doesn't attend the test

2. Required Documentation

- When prompted by Edutest, upload:
 - Last two academic reports
 - Most recent NAPLAN results
 - Any other relevant supporting documentation

3. Testing Day

- Attend scholarship testing at Immanuel Lutheran College
- Testing is conducted by Edutest, an independent organisation
- The College does not provide candidates with actual scores or order of merit

4. Interview Stage

- Shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview with the Principal or appointed delegate
- All candidates (successful and unsuccessful) will be notified of outcomes via email

Drama Requirements

During Scholarship

Recipients must:

 Must participate in a leadership/mentorship role (specialising in directing and producing) in assigned Drama activities. These will be decided in consultation early each new academic year with an assigned subject teacher or the Head of Arts. Some examples may include:

- Presenting at regular College events such as Worship and Assemblies
- Solo performance items
- Performance in the College Musicals
- Community Performances
- Workshops for younger students
- Clubs
- Arts Showcase/events
- Drama Scholarship recipients are expected to actively participate at a high level in the College's Drama program.
- Scholarship recipients must study Drama in Years 11 & 12 as a condition of their scholarship.

Performance Review

Drama Scholarship students' academic performance and dedication to their studies will be monitored each semester to ensure compliance with their obligations

Terms and Conditions

Eligibility and Award

- 1. Scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the Principal
- Open to domestic students only (not available to full overseas feepaying students)
- Available for students entering Years 7 to 11 in 2026

Duration and Maintenance

- Scholarships cover the entire period of enrolment at Immanuel Lutheran College
- Recipients must, throughout their entire scholarship period:
- Maintain high level involvement in Drama
- Demonstrate consistent attendance
- Participate in College events as requested
- Uphold College values and behaviour standards



Performance Review Process

The College reserves the right to assess a student's performance or conduct at any time. If requirements are not met:

- 1. First Step: Counselling session scheduled
- 2. Second Step: Formal warning letter issued detailing required scholarship requirements
- **3.** Final Step: If a second unsatisfactory review occurs, the Principal may reduce or revoke the scholarship

Additional Conditions:

Scholarship may be rescinded if College regulations or policies are breached

Scholarships cannot be deferred for a later year of entry

If a student leaves the College (whether withdrawing or cancelling enrolment) and later returns, their scholarship will not be reinstated

Only one scholarship may be held at a time



Important Notes

- All fees must be paid by the due date per the College's Fee & Billing Policy
- The Principal's decision regarding scholarship awards is final
- Immanuel Lutheran College will not engage in disputes regarding awarding scholarships

For New Students

Successful applicants who are new to Immanuel will have their application and enrolment confirmation fees waived as part of their scholarship package
