Eligibility

- Demonstrate high level of creativity and knowledge in film/media production techniques
- Sound academic achievement
- Available for students entering Years 7 to 11 in 2026

Application Process

1. Submit Application

RØDE

- Apply online via our Film & TV Scholarship Application Form
- Complete registration and pay the registration fee
- Submit samples of your film or media productions:
 - Must be provided as YouTube or Vimeo links
 - USBs will not be accepted
 - Include a variety of work that showcases your abilities

2. Interview Preparation

If shortlisted:

- A pitch for an original moving image product concept (such as a short film, documentary, or music video) for an external initiative or competition
- Be ready to discuss your creative process and technical choices
- Prepare to talk about your portfolio and previous work
- Show understanding of different production techniques

3. Interview Stage

- Shortlisted candidates will attend an audition and interview with the selection panel
- All candidates (successful and unsuccessful) will be notified via email



Film & Media Program Participation Requirements

Recipients must:

- Participate in leadership/mentorship roles in Film & TV activities
- Assist with filming and editing media for college events
- Actively seek external initiatives and competition opportunities
- Take an active role in the College's Film & TV program
- Study Film & TV in Years 11 & 12
- Maintain consistent academic performance

Terms and Conditions

Eligibility and Award

- 1. Scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the Principal
- 2. Open to domestic students only (not available to full overseas feepaying students)
- 3. Available for students entering Years 7 to 11 in 2026

Duration and Maintenance

- Scholarships cover the entire period of enrolment at Immanuel
- Recipients must, throughout their entire scholarship period:
 - Maintain sound academic achievement
 - Demonstrate consistent attendance
 - Participate in College events as requested
 - Uphold College values and behaviour standards



Performance Review Process

The College reserves the right to assess a student's performance or conduct at any time. If requirements are not met:

- 1. First Step: Counselling session scheduled
- 2. Second Step: Formal warning letter issued detailing required scholarship requirements
- **3.** Final Step: If a second unsatisfactory review occurs, the Principal may reduce or revoke the scholarship

Additional Conditions:

Scholarship may be rescinded if College regulations or policies are breached

Scholarships cannot be deferred for a later year of entry

If a student leaves the College (whether withdrawing or cancelling enrolment) and later returns, their scholarship will not be reinstated

Only one scholarship may be held at a time



Important Notes

- All fees must be paid by the due date per the College's Fee & Billing Policy
- The Principal's decision regarding scholarship awards is final
- Immanuel Lutheran College will not engage in disputes regarding awarding scholarships

For New Students

Successful applicants who are new to Immanuel will have their application and enrolment confirmation fees waived as part of their scholarship package
