- Up to 50% reduction in tuition fee
- Application and enrolment confirmation fees waived for new students
- Scholarship duration covers your entire enrolment period at Immanuel (subject to meeting conditions)

Please note: The scholarship applies to tuition fees only and does not cover additional costs such as resource levy, camps, uniforms, etc.

Eligibility

- To apply for a Music Scholarship, the applicant must have attained a minimum Level/Grade 4 AMEB/Trinity or equivalent on their chosen instrument/Voice. Candidates must also demonstrate sound academic achievement.
- Candidates entering Years 7 to 11 are eligible to apply.

Application Process

✓ 1. Submit Application

- Apply online via our Music Scholarship Application Form
- Complete registration and pay the registration fee
- Submit your audition video:
 - Two contrasting pieces (maximum 2 minutes each)
 - Must be provided as a YouTube or Vimeo link
 - USBs will not be accepted

✓ 2. Audition Preparation

If shortlisted:

- Prepare two contrasting performance pieces (can be the same as video submissions)
- Be ready to demonstrate technical ability through:
 - Major/minor scales/arpeggios at your performance level
 - All scales and arpeggios must be performed by memory
- If you play multiple instruments, be prepared to demonstrate ability on each
- Provide your own accompanist if required
- Be prepared to answer questions about your musical experience and goals

✓ 3. Interview Stage

- Shortlisted candidates will attend an audition and interview with the Head of Arts and Coccrricular Music Coordinator
- All candidates (successful and unsuccessful) will be notified via email



Music Program Participation Requirements

Recipients must:

- Actively participate at a high level in the College's music program
- Engage in at least two ensembles, including rehearsals
- Perform at various school events when directed
- Represent the College at external events/competitions
- Study Music in Years 11 & 12
- Maintain consistent academic performance

Terms and Conditions

Eligibility and Award

1. Scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the Principal
2. Open to domestic students only (not available to full overseas fee-paying students)
3. Available for students entering Years 7 to 11 in 2026

Duration and Maintenance

- Scholarships cover the entire period of enrolment at Immanuel
- Recipients must, throughout their entire scholarship period:
 - Maintain sound academic achievement
 - Demonstrate consistent attendance
 - Participate in College events as requested
 - Uphold College values and behaviour standards



Performance Review Process

The College reserves the right to assess a student's performance or conduct at any time. If requirements are not met:

- 1. First Step:** Counselling session scheduled
- 2. Second Step:** Formal warning letter issued detailing required scholarship requirements
- 3. Final Step:** If a second unsatisfactory review occurs, the Principal may reduce or revoke the scholarship

Additional Conditions:

Scholarship may be rescinded if College regulations or policies are breached

Scholarships cannot be deferred for a later year of entry

If a student leaves the College (whether withdrawing or cancelling enrolment) and later returns, their scholarship will not be reinstated

Only one scholarship may be held at a time



Important Notes

- All fees must be paid by the due date per the College's Fee & Billing Policy
- The Principal's decision regarding scholarship awards is final
- Immanuel Lutheran College will not engage in disputes regarding awarding scholarships

Successful applicants who are new to Immanuel will have their application and enrolment confirmation fees waived as part of their scholarship package
