Scholarship Value

- 50% reduction in tuition fees
 - Application and enrolment confirmation fees waived for new students
 - Scholarship duration covers your entire enrolment period at Immanuel (subject to meeting conditions)
 - Financial support available if selected for specific representative teams
 - Possibility of waived fees for chosen sport in external competitions
- Please note:** The scholarship applies to tuition fees only and does not cover additional costs such as resource levy, camps, uniforms, etc.



Eligibility

Sporting Achievement

Demonstrate talent and future potential in one or more of these sports:

- Swimming
- Cross Country
- Athletics
- Touch Football
- Australian Rules Football
- Basketball
- Volleyball
- Netball
- Tennis
- Rugby Union (7s or 15-a-side)
- Soccer
- Water Polo

Performance Level

- Must have achieved team selection at Regional, State, or National level in the last 2 years
- Note: Only achievements through Sunshine Coast Regional Sport and Queensland School Sport official school pathways will be considered
- Achievements through club pathways or external sporting pathways will not be considered

Additional Requirements

- Sound academic achievement
- High standard of effort and behaviour in all aspects of schooling
- Available for students entering Years 7 to 11 in 2026



Application Process

✓ 1. Submit Application

- Apply online via our Sport Scholarship Application Form
- Complete registration and pay the registration fee
- Provide required documentation:
 - Letter of reference from a coach addressing sporting ability, sportsmanship, and commitment to training
 - Letter of reference from a teacher or school representative addressing achievements, character and dedication
 - Last two academic reports
 - NAPLAN results

✓ 2. Interview Preparation

If shortlisted, prepare:

- A 4-minute presentation (visual aids may be used) covering:
 - Your sporting goals
 - Past sporting performances
 - How you will contribute to the College if awarded a scholarship
- Be ready to discuss your sporting journey and aspirations
- Parents/guardians will also be included in the interview process

✓ 3. Interview Stage

- Shortlisted candidates will attend an interview with the selection panel
- All candidates (successful and unsuccessful) will be notified via email

Sporting Program Participation Requirements

Recipients must:

- Represent the College in their chosen sport and at least one other sport during the school year
- Participate in leadership/mentorship roles (e.g., Primary School Carnival days, U8 Days, managing Junior SCISSA Teams)
- Be available for College sporting events and teams when needed
- Maintain consistent academic performance
- Demonstrate exemplary behaviour and commitment

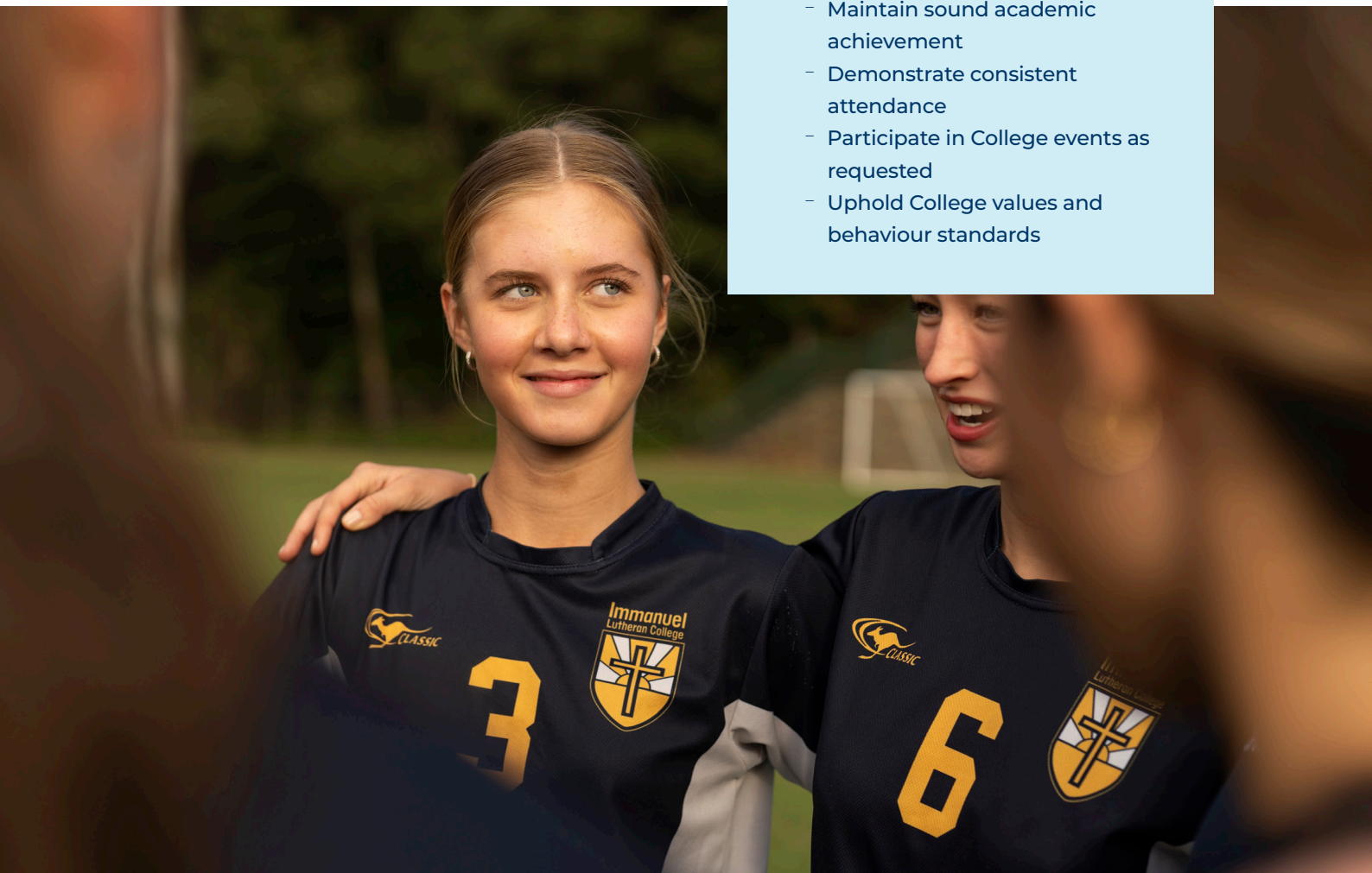
Terms and Conditions

Eligibility and Award

1. Scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the Principal
2. Open to domestic students only (not available to full overseas fee-paying students)
3. Available for students entering Years 7 to 11 in 2026

Duration and Maintenance

- Scholarships cover the entire period of enrolment at Immanuel Lutheran College
- Recipients must, throughout their entire scholarship period:
 - Maintain sound academic achievement
 - Demonstrate consistent attendance
 - Participate in College events as requested
 - Uphold College values and behaviour standards



Performance Review Process

The College reserves the right to assess a student's performance or conduct at any time. If requirements are not met:

1. **First Step:** Counselling session scheduled
2. **Second Step:** Formal warning letter issued detailing required scholarship requirements
3. **Final Step:** If a second unsatisfactory review occurs, the Principal may reduce or revoke the scholarship

Additional Conditions:

Scholarship may be rescinded if College regulations or policies are breached

Scholarships cannot be deferred for a later year of entry

If a student leaves the College (whether withdrawing or cancelling enrolment) and later returns, their scholarship will not be reinstated

Only one scholarship may be held at a time

Important Notes

- All fees must be paid by the due date per the College's Fee & Billing Policy
- The Principal's decision regarding scholarship awards is final
- Immanuel Lutheran College will not engage in disputes regarding awarding scholarships

For New Students

Successful applicants who are new to Immanuel will have their application and enrolment confirmation fees waived as part of their scholarship package
