Scholarship Value

- Up to 50% reduction in tuition fees
- Application and enrolment confirmation fees waived for new students
- Scholarship duration covers your entire enrolment period at Immanuel (subject to meeting conditions)

Please note: The scholarship applies to tuition fees only and does not cover additional costs such as resource levy, camps, uniforms, etc.

Eligibility

- Demonstrate an advanced conceptual and refined approach to artwork
- Show technique, skill and knowledge of the Elements and Principles of Art through various media
- Sound academic achievement
- Available for students entering Years 7 to 11 in 2026



Application Process

✓ 1. Submit Application

- Apply online via our Visual Art Scholarship Application Form
- Complete registration and pay the registration fee
- Prepare a digital portfolio using PowerPoint showcasing at least six pieces of work:
 - Include a brief description for each piece covering:
 - Date of creation
 - Media used
 - Timeline
 - Background and inspiration
 - Creative process

✓ 2. Portfolio and Interview Preparation

If shortlisted:

- Attend interview with selection panel
- Complete a practical drawing exercise before the interview
- Be prepared to discuss your portfolio and artistic journey
- Demonstrate understanding of various artistic techniques
- Share your creative aspirations and goals

✓ 3. Interview Stage

- Shortlisted candidates will attend an interview with the selection panel
- All candidates (successful and unsuccessful) will be notified via email



Visual Arts Program Participation Requirements

Recipients must:

- Maintain high achievement in the Visual Arts curriculum
- Participate in leadership/mentorship roles in Visual Art activities
- Contribute to exhibitions and displays
- Support younger students through workshops and mentoring
- Participate in Arts events and showcases
- Study Visual Art in Years 11 & 12
- Take an active role in the College's Visual Art program

Terms and Conditions

Eligibility and Award

1. Scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the Principal
2. Open to domestic students only (not available to full overseas fee-paying students)
3. Available for students entering Years 7 to 11 in 2026

Duration and Maintenance

- Scholarships cover the entire period of enrolment at Immanuel
- Recipients must, throughout their entire scholarship period:
 - Maintain exemplary academic performance
 - Demonstrate consistent attendance
 - Participate in College events as requested
 - Uphold College values and behaviour standards



Performance Review Process

The College reserves the right to assess a student's performance or conduct at any time. If requirements are not met:

1. **First Step:** Counselling session scheduled
2. **Second Step:** Formal warning letter issued detailing required scholarship requirements
3. **Final Step:** If a second unsatisfactory review occurs, the Principal may reduce or revoke the scholarship

Additional Conditions:

Scholarship may be rescinded if College regulations or policies are breached

Scholarships cannot be deferred for a later year of entry

If a student leaves the College (whether withdrawing or cancelling enrolment) and later returns, their scholarship will not be reinstated

Only one scholarship may be held at a time



Important Notes

- All fees must be paid by the due date per the College's Fee & Billing Policy
- The Principal's decision regarding scholarship awards is final
- Immanuel Lutheran College will not engage in disputes regarding awarding scholarships

Successful applicants who are new to Immanuel will have their application and enrolment confirmation fees waived as part of their scholarship package
