## OPERATING HOURS

Operating Hours: 7:30am - 6:00pm

Our service opens at 7:30am during Vacation Care, **children cannot be signed in before this time due to childcare licensing laws.** Our service closes at 6:00pm. **After 6:00pm a late fee of \$20 will incur for the first 15 minutes and \$1 per minute thereafter.**

## CHILD PROTECTION

At Immanuel OSHC, we are committed to providing a safe, supportive, and inclusive environment for every child. The well-being of children is our highest priority, and all educators have a legal and ethical responsibility to protect children from harm.

### All educators at our service:

- Hold a current Blue Card (Working with Children Check).
- Complete mandatory annual Child Protection training.
- Are trained to identify signs of abuse or neglect and follow the correct reporting procedures.
- Maintain professional boundaries and uphold confidentiality at all times.
- All staff complete the National Child Safety training (Gecco) every 3 years.

## FOOD & CLOTHING

Our service provides afternoon tea each day unless otherwise indicated. Children are required to bring a nutritional morning tea and lunch each day (nut free). Children are required to wear sun safe and appropriate clothing each day (preferably no school uniforms). No singlets, midriff tops, thongs/sandals or clothing with inappropriate images or texts. Please bring a spare change of clothes.

## EXCURSIONS

If there is an excursion scheduled for your booked session, your child must attend the excursion. Please be aware of the time you are required to arrive at the service. Please ensure your child brings a packed lunch, water bottle and enclosed shoes. All children are required to wear an excursion hat as per our risk assessments. Each excursion requires a signed permission form beforehand.

# WEEK 3



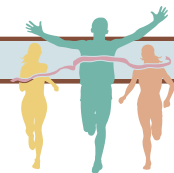
## Monday 6<sup>th</sup> July - Excursion to Bankfoot House \$30\*

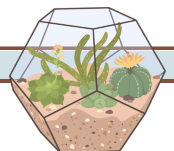
## Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July - Little Athletics Incursion \$20\*
